The Living Fire of Tradition – Forum “The Route of the Carpet”, Kotel, Bulgaria

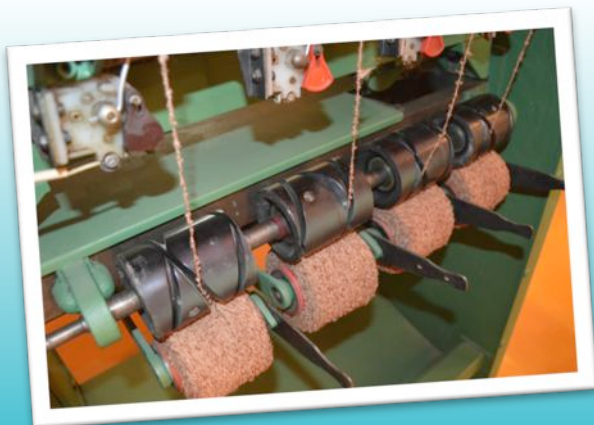
